Disclaimers

- ATS's Statement of Fees is an estimation based upon the information initially provided by the student – prior to enrolment and subject to change.
- Eligibility criteria must be met for state government subsidies to apply.
- Concessions do not apply to Fee for Service students.
- If the student is found to not meet the eligibility criteria for a government subsidy, the student will be issued with an amended Statement of Fees. The updated Statement of Fees – showing the full cost to the student - will be issued prior to enrolment. The student will have no obligation to continue.
- A student whose enrolment is Victorian Government subsidised may be entitled to a further concession on their tutorial / tuition fee if they meet the additional eligibility criteria.
- Under the Indigenous completion initiative, Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students pay only the concession tuition fee, i.e. 20% of the tuition fee for the course. The Indigenous completion initiative applies for government subsidised training at all qualification levels.
